Mathematical Approaches to Medieval Books

Abstract: Application of mathematical science in industry, as well as in a wide variety of other fields—ranging from economics and computation, to branches of the life sciences and physical sciences—is a widespread practice. Perhaps less familiar is the deployment of mathematical methods in the Humanities. Yet, recent years have seen growing recognition of quantification as a useful tool in humanistic research. This talk will focus on the application of mathematics in the study of medieval books, providing an overview of some recent research and pointing mathematicians towards potential opportunities for collaborative research.
